Having said that, we want to list out the deadlines that are approaching in regards to tax returns, both business and personal.

<b>Tax Return Deadlines</b>			
<b>Type of Return</b>	<b>Due Date</b>	<b>Need Extension?</b>	<b>Extended until when?</b>
"S" Corporation	March 15th	Yes	6 months-until September 15th
"C" Corporation	March 15th	Yes	6 months-until September 15th
Partnership Returns	April 15th	Yes	5 months-until September 15th
Tax Exempt Organizations	April 15th	Yes	3 months-until July 15th
All 1040 Personal Returns	April 15th	Yes	6 months-until October 15th

If your return will not be filed before the original due date, please make sure that an extension gets filed for both your business and personal returns in order to avoid penalties and interest. If we filed your return(s) for 2008, we will automatically file an extension for you if the return will not be completed before the deadline.
